## First Day Key Information:

- **Our campus opens at 7:15 when our crossing guard and monitor arrive.** Please never allow your child to leave your vehicle before that time.
- **If eligible, determine/review your child's transportation option in ParentVue.**
- **Meals Program:** Please refer to the food service website/flyer. All families must apply online for free/or reduced meals except for foster or EBT recipients, as our system automatically enrolls them in the program. You may drop your child off in the front loop at 7:15 if they are eating breakfast. There will be staff ready to greet them and guide them to the cafeteria doors. If your child is not eating breakfast, please drop them in the south valet loop (with colorful flags). I will be there to greet them. Students will be allowed to spend time on the playground until the bell rings but **should not be on campus earlier than 7:15.**
- **Students must bring a refillable water bottle to use every day. We have three touchless filling stations in our building and one located**
- **Our dismissal system has not changed, and is as follows:**

**Students walking** will exit through the back gate on Blacksburg Street.

**Bus or Daycare Van riders** will walk out together through the back gate and board buses or daycare vans on Blacksburg.

**All other students must be picked by a designated adult using our valet system in the south lot.** Please print the name of your child in big letters and place the paper on your dashboard so that teachers working the valet loop can easily read it. Our AMAZING Team volunteers with this task during their planning time, so **please be patient and remain in your vehicle. The process gets more efficient every day.**

**Note:** Kindergarten students and siblings will be escorted by a kindergarten teacher and must be met up in the overflow lot by a designated adult (refer to Kinder teacher letter for details). Again, for the safety of our students, we ask that you do NOT use the valet system for picking up your child. You should park in the overflow lot, get out of your vehicle, and wait at the gate with the sign provided by your child's teacher at the Ice Cream Social.
- **If you are not able to attend the ice cream social on August 1, please refer to the welcome letter that your child's teacher forwarded to you for class specific information.**
